Reception and Junior admissions

Reminder that if your child was born between 1 September 2013 and 31 August 2014 you need to apply for a Reception place for your child by January 15th 2018.

If your child is in Year 2 you need to apply for a Junior School place by January 15th 2018.

Children in our nursery are not automatically entitled to a Reception place in our school.

Mobile Phones in School

Diarrhoea and Sickness

We unfortunately have had a number of children off school with diarrhoea and sickness. The advice that we follow from the Health Protection in School guidance is that children should stay off school for 48 hours after the last time they have diarrhoea or are sick. Please make sure that you follow this guidance.
