| Overview of topic | This term topic is Fruit-tastic which is all about healthy eating. |
| Literacy focus | Children will read the story of Oliver's Vegetables. They will sequence the original events in the story and then write their own version of the story. Children will look at a range of non-fiction leaflets and then write their own leaflet based on how to stay healthy linking into our science topic. |
| Maths focus | Children will begin the year by a unit of work based around place value. They will practise reading and writing numbers in words and numerals. Children will recognise that 2 digit numbers are made up of tens and ones. |
