To help your child with their reading, please try to hear them read at home 3 or 4 times per week or every day if you are able. Please make a note in their school reading record every time you hear them read. When your child has read at home 30 times, they will go to Mrs Moore to receive a special sticker and a prize from her reading challenge basket. The children are recognised in celebration assembly that they have completed a reading challenge and have their photo taken as a group and put up on display in the main entrance hall. At the end of the year the child will receive a raffle ticket for each reading challenge they have completed and these go in to the reading challenge raffle to win a gift voucher. The more reading they complete the more chances they have to win the reading challenge raffle at the end of the year.
