This term's topic is **Stories**. This week's activities are on the theme of **The Three Pigs**



- Make a story map drawing pictures to tell the story. Use your story map to tell the story to a grown up. Can you write some sentences to go with the story or label some of the pictures?



- Draw a picture of a house.. Can you use your phonics to label the roof, window, chimney, door and garden. Which shapes can you see?
- Use a building set, such as lego, to make a model of a brick house. Can you make 3 houses of different sizes and put them in order of size starting with the smallest to the biggest?
- On your daily walk or in your garden (if you have one) collect materials to make a picture of a straw house (grass) and a stick house
- Use junk materials , such as a cereal box, to make a model of a house..
- Use your phonics to write a list of materials used by the pigs to build their house -straw, sticks, bricks etc.
- Can you use your phonics to write words that rhyme with pig? big, dig, fig, jig, pig, rig, tig , wig, zig?
