Maths


White Rose Maths Summer Term week 8 for year 1- learn about simple multiplication and division. whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-1/

Make sure you are completing work in the White Rose workbooks from school.

Learn what an **array** is.



Put things into arrays. and count how many rows and columns they have.



Using any objects can you practise doubling practically? Here is double 5

Then can you see if you can remember your doubles to at least 10 ? For example $1+1=2$, 2 and 2 is 4, double 3 is 6- try to say them in different ways.


Have a go at some more practical sharing- you could use any objects such as sweets, pennies or toys. Count your objects and share into equal groups. Do you have any left over?

Keep counting to 20 or 50 or 100 in steps of 2,5 and 10 . Can you do it forwards and backwards?

Keep practising counting to 100.

Here is the timetable showing you what we will be doing in school, which you could also follow at home.

Monday	Could you write a list of places that Hamish the cat saw on his adventure.
Tuesday	How did Hamish feel in different parts of the story ? Could you make a list of words to describe feelings? Write some simple sentences saying how someone feels. Remember capital letters, finger spaces and full stops
Wednesday	Draw a story map for the story of the Lighthouse keeper's cat. Write some labels on it naming some of the places.
Thursday	Write a story about a cat who has an adventure looking for a new home to live in. Make sure your story has a beginning, middle and end.

Look at yesterday's story. How could you make it better? Could you copy your story into a little book, with your best handwriting and some lovely drawings? Remember to make a cover with your name on it as the Author.
