Look at a 100 square. Can you count to 100?

Can you make a hundred square or find one on the internet? Use it to see how quickly you can find the numbers someone tells you to find.

Keep counting to 20 or 50 or 100 in steps of 2,5 and 10 . Can you do it forwards and backwards?

Think about the terms- **less than**, **greater than**, and **equal to**. Use these terms to compare two numbers. You could make cards with these terms on and use them with some number cards to make number sentences.


Keep practising counting to 100.

### Literacy

We are continuing stories this week. We are going to look at another story

from the Lighthouse Keeper series. This time the story is The Lighthouse Keeper's Rescue

Here is the timetable showing you what we will be doing in school.

Monday	There are lots of feeling talked about in the story. <b>Tired Mr Grinling</b> . <b>Worried Mrs Grinling</b> , <b>Cross Inspectors</b> . Can you write some sentences including 'feelings' words?
Tuesday	Verb work. Adding -ing to words and using them to write sentences. Remember capital letters, finger spaces and full stops
Wednesday	Drama - Act out the rescue story. Pretend it is the News report about the rescue. Could you think what Mr Grinling would say to the news reporter?
Thursday	Draw a story map for a rescue story like the one in The Lighthouse keeper's Rescue. Think of all the people who came to help get the whale back in the water.

Friday	Write your own rescue story about a whale. Make sure your story has a beginning, middle and end.
