

Maths

White Rose Maths Summer Term week 12 for year 1- practise telling the time to 1 hour using o'clock and to the half hour using half past. whiterosemaths.com/homelearning/year-1/

Make sure you are completing work in the White Rose workbooks from school.



Continuing our work on time, do you know the difference between hours, minutes and seconds ?

Can you try to learn that there are **60** seconds in a minute and **60** minutes in an hour and **24** hours in a day?

Can you use time words to compare such as later, earlier, faster and slower



Do you know all the names of the days of the week and the months of the year and the order they go in?



Literacy

We are looking at some more poetry this week and doing some scientific writing linked to plants.
