#### Welcome

A big welcome to school to the new children and families joining us, and a big welcome back to all the children and families returning this September. We are looking forward to an exciting year, with lots of fun activities planned, and opportunities for parents and carers to join in with school life. Please note the doors open from 8.45am - 8.55am for children to come in to school. Any child arriving after 8.55am will need to be signed in and the child will be marked as late.

#### **Toddler group**

Our school toddler group, led by Mrs Fox, will restart on Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> September, 9.00am – 11.00am in the school hall. There is a small charge of £1.50 per family to attend, and this includes a drink and snack. All local families with babies and toddlers are welcome to attend, you do not need to have a child at school, just live in the local area. #### **PE Days**

#### **Nursery places**

We still have some nursery places available this year. If you have a child who is 3 years old, or will soon be 3 years old, or you know someone who does, please speak to the school office for more information and to put the child's name down for a place at nursery. All 3 year olds are entitled to 15 hours of free nursery provision, and if parents/carers are working, they could be entitled to 30 hours of free nursery provision.
