School Reading Challenge

Children will bring a reading book home from school to practice at home. Children will receive a new book each week, and we encourage you to help your child read the book at least 3 or 4 times over the week. By reading the same book, children are practicing and developing their reading skills with an increasingly familiar book, which helps them to make progress with their reading.

Every time your child reads at home, please write a note in their reading record. When children have read at home 30 times, they will receive a prize and an award. There is a prize cabinet in the main entrance with lots of lovely prizes for the children to choose from. Children will also receive a bronze award for their first reading challenge, a silver for their second and a gold for their third.

Key Stage 1 After School Clubs

The following after school clubs will be available for Key Stage 1 children; this is children in Elephants (Miss Dunks) and Lions (Mrs Craggs).

Monday - Dance club

Thursday - Sports club

All clubs run from 3.15pm - 4.15pm and there is a weekly charge of £1.50 per club.

Dance club will start every Monday from 15th September until 20th October.

Gardening club will start every Tuesday from 16th September until 21st October.

Sports club will start every Thursday from 18th September until 23rd October

If you would like to book a place for your child at a club, please call in the school office to pay - it will be £9 for clubs for this term.

Children are expected to behave well during clubs, following the school's golden rules. Any child who disrupts clubs will no longer be able to attend.

Water Bottles

Children should bring a water bottle to school with them each day. Please ensure your child's name is on their water bottle and that it only contains plain water. Although many parents / carers tell us their children won't drink water at home, generally all children will drink water at school as this is the expectation. Just tell your child it is the school rule, so you can only put water in their school water bottle. Teachers are happy to reinforce this with your child if needed.
